- ☐ Draw pictures to show at least 6 classroom items. You can draw these or print out the flashcards in the Overview to colour. (Week 9)
- ☐ Stick the classroom items 'inside' the backpack (Week 9)
- ☐ Label each of the items in Japanese (hiragana or kanji) (Week 9)
- ☐ Write sentences to explain 'what's in your bag' by filling in the attached template. Can you complete a whole sentences in hiragana?! (Week 10)
- ☐ Record yourself (video or audio) reading your sentences aloud to explain what you have in your bag. (Week 10)
